- Program targeted to youth and young adults age **16-24**
- Must provide one or more right-to-work documents, such as social security card, CA ID, birth certificate, passport, etc.
- In school and under 18 must obtain a **work permit**
- Low income requirements may apply
- You are encouraged to apply if you receive public assistance such as SonomaWORKs (TANF)

\*Please note that this program has a built-in educational component, provides access to additional resources, and in some cases requires a year-round commitment.
